ELECTRICITY TARIFFS FOR THE PERIOD 01 JULY 2022 – 30 JUNE 2023

Your application dated 1 June 2022 refers.

The Energy Regulator at its meeting held on the 25 May 2022 approved the guideline increase of 7.47% for municipalities applicable for the 2022/23 financial year. Consequently, the Energy Regulator considered your application for a tariff increase for the period 1 July 2022 – 30 June 2023 and approved the tariffs as follows:

Domestic Prepaid

Block 1 (0 - 50 kWh)	R1.1650	c/kWh
Block 2 (51 – 350 kWh)	R1.6977	c/kWh
Block 3 (351 – 600 kWh)	R2.1296	c/kWh
