IMPLEMENTATION OF THE E-PARTICIPATORY GOVERNANCE AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (e-PGLUM) ICT.

- 1. The Department has implemented the e-Participatory Governance and Land Use Management ICT System known as E-PGLUM with effect from 1 October 2025. The system is an e-lodgement system that is to support municipalities to improve efficiency and effectiveness in the processing of land use development, building plan and outdoor advertising applications.
- The completed functions of the system include the following:
 - a) User administration to allow registration of users.
 - b) Land use management to receive, assess and process decisions on applications.
 - c) Outdoor advertising to receive, assess and process decisions on applications.
 - d) Building plans to receive, assess and process decisions on applications.
 - e) Compliance to receive, assess and process decisions on applications.
 - f) Appeals and Opposed Appeals to receive and consider appeals.
 - g) Comments, objection and intervention to receive comments (internal/external), objections and intervention on land development applications.
 - h) Management reports to provide reporting of system functionality and processed applications, assessments/evaluation, and decisions.
 - Citizen dashboard to allow citizen to register as users, submit applications, track progress, comment on applications or submit complaints and to lodge appeals or oppose appeals.

 Official Dashboard - to allow officials to verify and accept applications, evaluate applications, comment on applications and decide on applications.

k) Provide GIS integration including the integration with the National Spatial Planning Data Repository (NSPDR) being developed by Department of Rural Development and Land Reform.

- 3. The Municipalities are therefore informed that the e-PGLUM system is now live with effect from 1 October 2025 via web address epglum.co.za where applicants will have to register to access the system. Officials have been given credentials to access the system to enable them to process applications within the system.
- 4. The municipality through its communication platforms is requested to inform the general public and professional bodies/agents of the live e-PGLUM system and to register and submit applications on land use management via the system with effect from 1 October 2025.
