PROTECTION OF WATER INFRASTRUCTURE

The Victor Khanye Local Municipality (VKLM) wishes to urgently call upon all residents to assist in protecting municipal water infrastructure against theft, vandalism, and illegal activities. The municipality's primary sources of water supply are boreholes, which form a critical part of the Botleng Water Supply Scheme. Any damage, theft, or tampering with borehole infrastructure, pumps, electrical components, or pipelines directly affects the municipality's ability to supply water to the community. Such acts may result in water shortages, prolonged interruptions, and costly repairs, ultimately impacting residents and businesses. All acts of vandalism and theft are criminal offences and will be dealt with in terms of the applicable laws.
